1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORTING ON SOLID START PROGRAM OF DE-**  
4 **PARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

5 (a) REPORTS REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days  
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually  
7 thereafter, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall submit

1 to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and  
2 House of Representatives a report on the Solid Start pro-  
3 gram of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

4 (b) ELEMENTS.—Each report under subsection (a)  
5 shall include the following:

6 (1) With respect to each veteran called or  
7 emailed under the Solid Start program:

8 (A) The Armed Force of the veteran.

9 (B) Age.

10 (C) Gender.

11 (D) Whether the veteran responded to the  
12 call or email.

13 (E) Whether the call or email resulted in  
14 a call to the Veterans Crisis Line established  
15 pursuant to section 1720F(h) of title 38,  
16 United States Code.

17 (F) Whether the call or email resulted in  
18 a referral to—

19 (i) compensation and pension deter-  
20 mination;

21 (ii) enrollment in the patient enroll-  
22 ment system of the Department; or

23 (iii) any other program or benefit  
24 under the laws administered by the Sec-  
25 retary.

1           (2) Any change to the Solid Start program im-  
2           plemented by the Secretary since the date of the pre-  
3           vious such report.

4           (c) PROHIBITION ON PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE IN-  
5           FORMATION.—No report under subsection (a) may contain  
6           any personally identifiable information regarding a vet-  
7           eran.
